

**Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)**  
(For a nine-hole handicap-posting only)

**How to adjust your score**

Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) sets a maximum number of strokes that a player can POST on any hole and is incumbent upon that player's Course Handicap.

For handicap purposes, a player is required to adjust hole scores when they are higher than the player's ESC number.

There is no limit to the number of holes on which a player can adjust hole scores and a player must adjust all scores for Handicap purposes, including tournament scores.

**Nine Hole Course Handicap**

**Maximum Score On Any Hole**

<b>4 or less</b>	<b>Double Bogey (2 over par)</b>
<b>5 through 9</b>	<b>7</b>
<b>10 through 14</b>	<b>8</b>
<b>15 through 19</b>	<b>9</b>
<b>20 or more</b>	<b>10</b>

**To Apply ESC:**

Look at your score for any hole where your score is higher than the maximum score allowed. (See above)

Reduce higher scores to the maximum score allowed for handicap posting purposes.

When turning your scorecard into the Pro, circle the score to be adjusted and show both totals.
